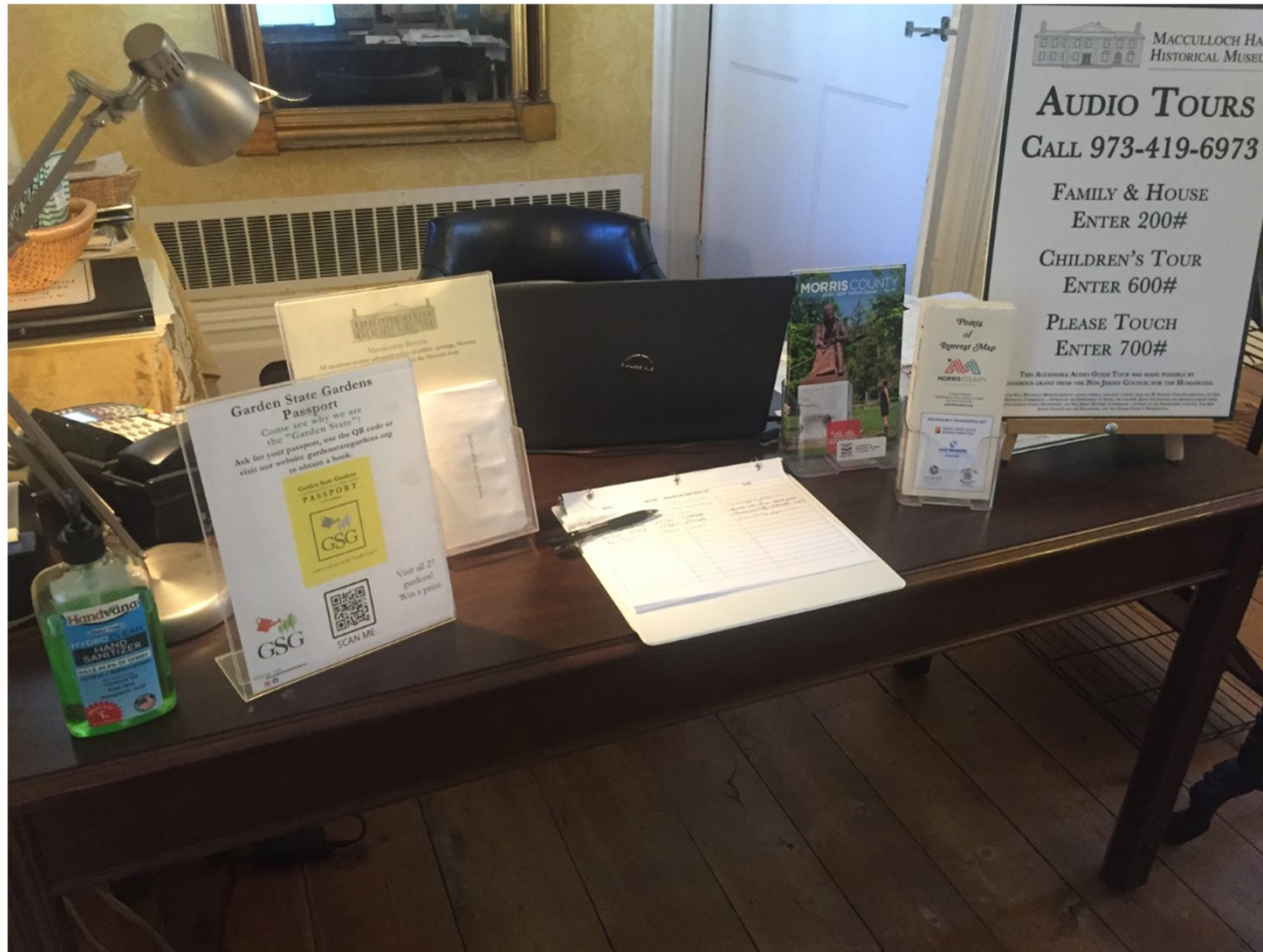


Visiting Macculloch Hall Historical Museum
